

Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

The company In-es.artdesign srls, operates both directly and indirectly on an International level through distribution agreements.

This website, which is owned by **In-es.artdesign srls.** - contains information directly concerning the company.

The purpose of this privacy policy statement is to describe the operation of this website in terms of the processing of personal data of users/visitors who consult the site.

In accordance with applicable privacy legislation, **In-es.artdesign srls.** seeks to ensure the privacy and personal data security of each visitor, including when the site is accessed from outside Italy, in line with the provisions in this policy.

Unless indicated otherwise, this Policy should also be understood as providing general information on the processing of the personal data of those who interact with the services provided through the site. Where necessary, detailed policy statements on personal data processing are provided on the pages corresponding to the services rendered through the site.

Such policy statements are intended to set out the limits and methods of data processing for each service, thereby enabling visitors to freely express their consent and duly authorize the collection and subsequent use of data.

Note that this Privacy Policy does not extend to any other websites which users may access through a hypertext link (hyperlink).

2. Roles and responsibilities in the field of privacy

The data controller for the company's data is the company In-es.artdesign srls. with registered office at Piazza della Suburra, 6 00184 Rome Italy.

The privacy officer for web services provided is the *pro tempore* head of Operational Marketing.

Personal data may be processed by internal or external persons appointed by the privacy officer or by data processors tasked with managing the requested service.

3. Type of data processed and the purpose of processing

The website provides informative and in some cases interactive content. Accordingly, information on visitors to the site can be acquired by the following means:

- *Browsing data*

During their normal operation, the computer systems and software procedures used by this website acquire some personal data, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols.

This category of personal data includes: IP addresses, the type of browser used, the operating system, the domain name and addresses of websites from which this website has been accessed or to which it is exited, information on pages visited by users within the site, the time of access, the duration of visits to an individual page, internal path analyses and other parameters of the operating system and informatics environment.

This technical/informatics data is collected and used exclusively in an aggregated and anonymous form but may be used to establish liability in the event of computer-related crime to the detriment of the site.

- *Data provided voluntarily by visitors*

This is personal data provided freely by visitors to the site, for example in order to register and/or access a restricted area, to request information about a particular product or service using a form or by email, or a phone request to the direct contact number of our customer service department.

Where provided, this information can be used for the purposes of user profiling. In such cases, the relevant policy statement will be provided and the user's free and specific consent will be obtained in the manner established in the applicable privacy legislation (initially consent is obtained through an "opt-in" procedure and subsequently consent may be refused by an "opt-out").

4. Technologies Used

Cookies are packets of information sent by a web server (e.g. the website) to the user's Internet browser, which are automatically stored on your computer and sent to the server with each subsequent access to the site.

Almost all browsers are set to accept cookies automatically by default.

Visitors can set their computer's browser to accept/reject all cookies or to alert whenever a cookie is offered, so that the visitor can assess whether or not to accept it. It is possible to change the default configuration and disable cookies (i.e. block them definitively) by setting a higher security level.

5. Methods of data processing

The processing of personal data is mainly carried out by electronic procedures (DB, CRM platforms, etc.) for the time necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data is collected and in all cases in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, propriety, relevance and proportionality as provided in applicable privacy legislation.

6. Redirects to external websites

The website may use social plug-ins. Social plug-ins are special tools that enable the incorporation of the functions of a social network (e.g. the Facebook "like" function) into the website.

All social plug-ins present in the website bear the logo of the owners of the relevant social network platform (e.g. Facebook, Google+, Twitter, etc.).

When a page on our website is visited and an interaction takes place with a plug-in (e.g. by clicking on the "like" button), or the visitor wishes to leave a comment, the browser sends the corresponding information directly to the social network platform, which stores it.

7. Connecting to and from third party sites

The owner of the website accepts no liability arising from any requests for and/or release of personal data to third party sites in relation to the management of authentication credentials provided by third parties.

8. Rights of persons concerned

Persons to whom personal data processed through this website refers ("persons concerned"), may exercise their rights by the methods and within the limits established by privacy legislation applicable in Italy.

Cookie Policy

1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy sets out the types, methods of use of cookies, and to provide information on the type of cookies present in the website.

2. What are cookies and how are they used?

Cookies are packets of information sent by a web server (e.g. the website) to the user's Internet browser, which are automatically stored on your computer and sent to the server with each subsequent access to the site.

Almost all browsers are set to accept cookies automatically by default.

This website uses only the following categories of cookies:

- "session cookies" these are cookies that are not permanently stored on the user's computer and are deleted when the browser is closed. They are strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers necessary to enable the website to be browsed safely and efficiently. They prevent use of other technologies that could compromise users privacy
- "technical or analytical first party cookies" are cookies administered directly by the owner and/or manager of the website which are used for authentication, to benefit from multimedia content of the 'flash player' type, and to enable selection of the browsing language. Therefore it is not generally necessary to obtain the user's prior and informed consent.
- *Analytical "third party" cookies* are created and made available by third parties, and used to collect and analyse statistical information on access/visits to the website via the collection of information in an aggregated and anonymous form (for example, through the masking of significant portions of the IP address). The information is not crossed with other information already in the third party's possession

3. How to disable cookies through browser configuration.

Technical-type cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of the site. Uninstalling and/or deleting them could affect your browsing of the website.
